All maintenance must be performed by a qualified person using proper tools and safety procedures. All maintenance must be performed while the tractor is uncoupled from the trailer

GENERAL FIFTH WHEEL INSPECTION

The following must be performed every 30,000 miles or 3 months, whichever comes first.

Thoroughly steam clean the fifth wheel to assure that a correct detailed inspection can be carried out.

Check security and torque of mounting bolts, tighten or replace as necessary.

Inspect the fifth wheel assembly for damaged, broken or missing parts, replace as necessary (use only genuine Holland Parts).

Re-lubricate as shown below


Test the operation of the fifth wheel locking mechanism, ensure proper locking as shown opposite

LUBRICATION

Lubricate with a light oil - SAE 10W or 20W

Camplate profile and washers

Re-grease top surface (trailer contact area) with a water-resistant lithium base grease



Grease using a "low temp." grade recommended for -36°C or lower



Do not use any fifth wheel which does not operate properly
