

SIMPLEX® SERIES and CASTLOC® SERIES Lock Replacement

Check the components of this package. The following parts should be included in this kit. If you didn't receive an item, please contact your dealer or distributor.

Disassembly

1. Lock the fifth wheel jaw mechanism using a bar (*Figure 1*).

The lock is spring-loaded. To avoid injury, keep hands away from lock and jaw. Use a bar to rotate jaw when opening or closing the locking mechanism. When locking the jaw, stand clear of the extended operating rod handle, as it retracts rapidly.





Figure 2 (Mounting Brackets not shown)

2. Remove the clinch pins and the bracket pins at both sides (*Figure 2*). The bracket pins may need to be removed by tapping with a hammer.

3. If the pins are difficult to remove, compress the fifth wheel down against the mounting bracket trunnions with a clamp or other suitable means

- (for example, placing it under a light trailer), to relieve the upward pressure on the bracket pins, due to the polyurethane shoes and pads.
- **4.** Using a chain hoist, carefully turn over the fifth wheel plate assembly to expose its underside.
 - **DO NOT** use the operating handle to move or lift the fifth wheel.
- **5.** Remove the cotter pin and lever bar pin (*Figure 3*).
- 6. Take the slotted spring pin out of the operating rod and remove the rod. For some older models, remove the cotter pin and washer and then remove the operating rod (Figure 4).



ACAUTION

The lock spring is under compression.

7. Slide the cover plate back until clear of top plate tabs, lift and remove. For other models, slide the

cover plate tabs further into the bracket pocket slots (remove poly shoe) until clear of top plate tabs, lift and remove (*Figure 5*).



- **8.** Slide the lever bar forward, lift and remove (not shown).
- **9.** Carefully lift up on the lock and lock spring and remove (*Figure 6*).
- **10.** Clean any build up of grease and dirt from the lock pocket area and components.

Reassembly

- 1. Lubricate the top plate lock area and the locking mechanism parts. Reassemble the parts in the reverse order of disassembly.
- 2. When installing the lock and lock spring, install them as a unit. Place them into the fifth wheel with the lock seated and the lock spring partially sticking up. Push down on the lock spring and lock to get both pieces in place.
