WARNING

Maintain adequate vertical (tongue) load to properly control the trailer (generally 10%) but do not exceed the above rated capacities.

### **TOWING APPLICATIONS:**

Trailers and equipment designed for over-the-road towing within the stated capacities. For off-road applications, reduce the capacities above by 25% and use in conjunction with a swivel type drawbar.

#### **DRAWBAR EYE DIMENSIONS:**

2" to 3" I.D. with 1.25" to 1.63" diameter section.

#### **MOUNTING:**

- Use a mounting structure of sufficient strength to support the rated capacity of the pintle hook in accordance with SAE J849 and SAE J847 respectively.
- Use the hole pattern described on the reverse.
- Use (4) .5" grade 8 fasteners, properly tightened.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Before operating, inspect for proper operation, worn, damaged or missing parts and secure mounting. Correct as required before use.
- Open latch (XA-76-A) by removing cotter pin (A) and lifting lock (B).
- Position drawbar eye over the horn of the pintle and lower into place.



**DO NOT** damage the latch. Be particularly careful with the drawbar when coupling and uncoupling.

Close the latch and insert the cotter pin. Spread the cotter pin to retain position.

Other steps and inspections are also required. Consult OSHA and D.O.T. regulations and American Trucking Association for complete coupling and uncoupling procedures. These cover items such

as cargo securement, brakes, lights, safety chains, and other important requirements.

#### **MAINTENANCE:**

For proper performance, the following maintenance steps should be performed every 30,000 miles or 3 months, whichever comes first.

- Clean and check for proper operation. Inspect for worn, damaged or missing parts. Replace as required using only Holland parts.
- Inspect, in particular, the coupling contact area and periodically disassemble to inspect for wear on the shank mounting flanges. Replace any component when wear exceeds 1/8" (0.125") from the original surface profile.
- Regularly lubricate latch pivot with a light oil lubricant.
- Check mounting fasteners for proper torque.


#### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**
